

Oaths

These Oaths may be administered by the Recorder, or in the case of a hearing without recorder, by any one person to another, the affiant raising his right hand when being sworn.

1. Oath to be taken by Arbitrator: “Do you solemnly swear that you will faithfully and fairly hear and examine the matter in controversy and make a just Award, according to the best of your understanding?”

2. Oath to be taken by Witness: “Do you solemnly swear that the testimony you are about to give shall be the whole truth?”

3. Oath to be taken by Interpreter: “Do you solemnly swear that you will faithfully and fairly translate in a verbatim and objective manner from the - - - - - language to the - - - - - language or vice versa the oral or written communications you will be called upon to interpret?”
